#### Ensuring joint participation

- National Designated Authority (NDA) with the mandate to officially communicate with the Fund.
- Fulfils an important function of representing the priorities and interests of the country in a clear and transparent manner

#### **National Designated Authorities (NDAs)**

Currently, the Green Climate Fund has 145 original National Designated Authorities (NDAs) or designated focal points (focal points).


The type of NDA varies in different countries. They are mainly represented by the Ministries of the Environment or National Environmental Protection Agencies, but in some countries they are represented by the Ministries of Finance.



#### **Project/Programme Financing**

- Country, regional and / or accredited organization programs
- 2. Forming applications for funding programs or projects setting priorities based on 1.
- 3. Submission of a concept / application for funding through an Accredited Entity (AE)
- AEs must go through the "no objection" procedure and the approval of the NDA.
- Consideration and recommendations of the GCF Panel of Experts
- 6. Funding requests will be evaluated according to the GCF investment criteria.
- 7. GCF Board meets 3-4 times a year






